We have taken steps to ensure that this will not happen again by upgrading our watering system to ensure that the human error part is removed.

The four meetings that we did hold were excellent with huge crowds attending, good fields and ideal weather conditions. One of the highlights of the season was to see My Clementina win the Balnarring Cup and then go on and be named Picnic Horse of the Year.

Community Involvement

Balnarring Picnic Racing Club under our "Caring for the Community Programme" sets aside an amount of money every racing season to be distributed amongst charity and community groups

Again this year the Club will distribute a total of \$4000.00 to four local charities to assist them in their work. This year's recipients are:

- Womin Djeka Balnarring Ngargee

As well as the above grants the Club has supported a number of local sporting clubs, kindergartens, pre schools etc with their fund raising events.

During the season the Club donated \$1500 to the drought relief program in East Gippsland. The money was used for food and counselling for the farmers.

On the receiving side the Club gained a grant from the Bendigo Bank of \$5000 which we will use to purchase more aluminium picnic tables, some of which will be in the members area in front of the clubrooms and the balance in the area out back under the shade sails. This will give more members the opportunity to picnic in these areas. We thank the Bendigo Bank for their generous and ongoing support.

I must make special mention of our web master Rachel Rowe for the work she has done in updating our website and making it so user friendly. All bookings for marquees, roped off sites, picnic tables, admittance tickets, etc can now all be done online. This has made the task of arranging the race day so much easier. Rachel, we thank you for your great work.

In addition to those mentioned above there are many volunteers who offer their services at each of our race days and during the year; perform untold and selfless tasks and make our Club the place it is.

Thanks to our members, patrons and all who attended our 2018/19 race meetings and for your continued support.
