Norm McDonell and Lyn Tregillis

The year began with a very special tribute to two of our long-time volunteers! In August 2020 the committee agreed that Norm McDonell and Lyn Tregillis had fulfilled the principles for life membership at Balnarring.

The Balnarring Picnic Racing Club is proud to have inducted two new Life Members, Norm McDonell and Lyn Tregillis at the 2020 Annual General Meeting. Life membership is awarded to distinguished person who have contributed extra-ordinarily to fulfill to deliver the objectives of the Club

Norm was born in 1933 in the suburb of Caulfield where the family resided. His father was a horse trainer and Norm had a love of horses and racing from an early age, in fact he was riding trackwork when he was 9 or 10!

School did not agree with Norm so he left, he wanted to go to Queensland to become an apprentice jockey but his mother would not let him, so he became an apprentice barber, a profession he carried on around Mentone and Parkdale for over 50 years.



On the morning of the 1948 Balnarring Cup Norm cut hair as usual until 2 when he was picked up to come to Balnarring to ride Helenette in the cup for owner Mr Lou Abrahams and trainer Mr Jack Besanko. All of his gear was borrowed as this was his first ride in a race, he won the cup which turned out to be his only ever ride in a race!

After the race he collapsed and had to be assisted to weigh in.

Over the years Norm still rode trackwork regularly on some very good horses.

Norm we salute you for the voluntary work you have done at Balnarring over the years and you are very worthy of Life Membership.



Lyn first came to the Balnarring Races to assist with the selling of the famous five dollar raffle some 25 years ago.

Lyn was on the Ladies Committee that was headed up at the time by Vonnie Haysom.

PUNTERS CLUB


For a number of years the Balnarring Picnic Racing Club has run a punters' club at each of its meetings. The aim of the punters' club is to provide the opportunity for interested persons to be involved in a betting syndicate during the meetings. Whilst primarily focussed at providing this opportunity for inexperienced or novice punters experience has shown that experienced punters and groups also participate.

The punters club has proven to be a popular attraction for punters at Balnarring; 868 tickets were sold (\$17,360) and made a total profit of \$762 for the season, profit margin of +4.4% which is not a bad result over 6 race meetings.
